A sequel to **Shall we Join the Men?**, this new book for 2011 features many of Oliver's popular cartoons published as greeting cards, as well as new unseen drawings.

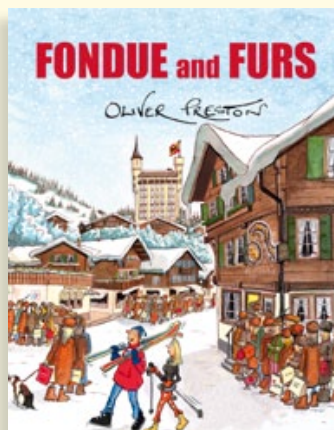
